#### **About College**

Rama Devi Bajla Mahila College, situated in the prime location of Deoghar is a Constituent Unit of Sido Kanhu Murmu University, Dumka. It was established in the year 1962 on 17th July by the prestigious Bajla family. This college advocates for women's empowerment, self-reliance and recognition. It began with seven students but now the strength of the students have risen to thousand times. The college runs two years Intermediate Course and Four Year Undergraduate programme for the faculty of Arts, Science and Commerce. The syllabus for all the streams are designed within the purview of NEP 2020.

This college spreads across 2.59 acres with lushed green campus. It has proper accommodation for female students who come from tribal background in the form of welfare hostel. The classrooms are equipped with smart boards to provide blended learning to the students.

The teachers are well-educated and experienced in their respective discipline. Along with the study, there is provision for extra-curricular activities simultaneously in the form of NSS and NCC. The college organizes co-curricular activities related to departmental seminars, quizzes, debate, yoga and other awareness programmes. It is dedicated towards the overall development of the girls studying here. There are various cells like Grievance Redressal cell, Women Cell IQAC cell, ST/SC Cell, Alumni cell, Anti-Ragging cell and several others . Many committees have been developed to tackle the problems faced by the students and teachers. It provides remedial courses for the academically weak students. It exercises Zero Tolerance Policy towards caste and religious discrimination. It encourages unity, equality, fraternity and justifiable action among the students.

Introduction: - The prestigious 'Bajla family' of Deoghar founded this college on '17th-July-1962' .It became a constituent college on 22.12.1980. The main objectives were women empowerment, emancipation and self-dependence. Since then it never looked back and starting with 7(Seven) students now it has more than 5709 (Five thousand seven hundred nine ) by arduous effort, dedication and sincerity. Now the college is known for its quality education, discipline

and excellent culture. It is a Premiere institution of higher education for women by providing "Intermediate" and "Under Graduate" courses not only to the students of Deoghar, but also to the whole Santhal Parganas, spread over in 1,13,040 sq.ft. = 2.59 acres. Situated in the lush green areas, the college posses its own building with all modern facilities and activities in the Baidyanath Dham, Deoghar. It has sufficient number of class-rooms for proper accommodation of the students and welfare hostel for the tribal students and minorities.
